### **RE: Offer Behaviour Enforcement Guidelines Stakeholder Meeting**

As outlined in the MSA's November 19, 2015 notice, on December 9<sup>th</sup> the MSA will be soliciting feedback from stakeholders on the need for changes to the Offer Behaviour Enforcement Guidelines and the nature of consultation associated with a potential "refresh" of the guidelines. The moderator for the meeting will be the MSA's Senior Legal Counsel, David Bell. The proposed agenda is as follows.

  - b. Would a version of the EUA / FEOC Regulation, annotated with relevant jurisprudence, be a useful alternative/compliment to guidelines?
  - c. Should sections of the OBEG be removed where there is specific guidance from the Commission?
