NOTICE TO MARKET PARTICIPANTS

Re: Request for MSA views regarding information sharing

ENMAX Power Corp (EPC) has received a request for historical Calgary Area hourly load SCADA data from another market participant. The data has been requested with a one month delay. EPC would charge the requesting participant any costs incurred. EPC has asked the MSA to provide its views on whether EPC is allowed to share this information with any market participant.

In the MSA's view, with respect to the sharing of the information specified above, there are no concerns regarding the impact of the information sharing on the fair, efficient and openly competitive operation of the market. The MSA notes that there is no obligation on EPC to provide this information but, should it choose to do so, it must be made available to all requesting participants under the same terms and conditions.

In accordance with Section 14 of the electricity Code of Conduct Regulation, EPC is permitted to share aggregate customer information, subject to certain conditions, with retailers. However, the MSA is of the opinion that EPC should be allowed to share this information with any market participant provided it meets the conditions noted above.

The MSA believes it is also important other market participants are informed that there is the opportunity to request this information, and that the views of the MSA are transparent. In publishing this notice the MSA believes it has achieved these two objectives.

Any stakeholders with a view that the sharing of information specified above is contrary to the fair, efficient and openly competitive operation of the market are requested to the contact the MSA immediately and to describe their concerns. Otherwise, no specific feedback is required in relation to this notice. However, stakeholders should feel free to contact Matt Ayres (403 705-3182) with comments or questions.
