enmax Power Corporation contravened Requirement 1(e) of EOP-008-AB-1 from June 23, 2024, to October 8, 2024, as its operating plan describing the manner in which it continues to meet its functional obligations with regard to the reliable operations of the bulk electric system in the event that its primary control centre functionality is lost was not sufficient to enable a transition period between the decision to transfer functionality to the back up control centre following the loss of primary control centre functionality and the time to fully implement the backup functionality that is less than or equal to two (2) hours.

Requirement 1 of EOP-008-AB-1 states, in part:

The ISO and each operator of a transmission facility must have a current operating plan describing the manner in which it continues to meet its functional obligations with regard to the reliable operations of the bulk electric system in the event that its primary control centre functionality is lost.

This operating plan for backup functionality must include the following, at a minimum:

(e) a transition period between the decision to transfer functionality to the back up control centre following the loss of primary control centre functionality and the time to fully implement the backup functionality that is less than or equal to two (2) hours;

The MSA is satisfied that the conduct was a contravention of Reliability Standard EOP-008-AB-1, requirement R1.

NOTICE
