### **EVENT DETAILS**

Between approximately 10:22 and 10:31 on September 26, 2018, the TLM2 generating asset received four consecutive dispatches which timed out without acknowledgement. Subsection 5 of section 201.7 of the ISO rules states, in part:

A pool participant must acknowledge receipt of a dispatch:

- (a) in the case of an automated message and unless the pool participant has notified the ISO of an unavailability in accordance with subsection 4(1)(a) by responding via the Automated Dispatch and Messaging System:
  - i. within two (2) minutes for an intra-Alberta transaction; [...]

## **FINDINGS**

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO rule 201.7.

#### **MATERIAL FACTS**

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

- 1. AESO dispatch data for TLM2 for September 26, 2018.
- 2. AESO information request issued to Repsol Canada Energy Partnership dated February 1, 2019.
- 3. Repsol Canada Energy Partnership's response to the AESO information request dated February 7, 2019.
- 4. Referral from the AESO to the MSA dated February 15, 2019.

## NOTICE
